  - Proposals are due on October 6, 2020
- Junior School Running Tracks Project is in the Bidding phase
  - Project is currently being advertised on the District's online bidding portal
  - Proposals are due on October 6, 2020
- **District-Wide Roof Replacement** Project is in the Design Development phase
  - 100% schematic design drawings are currently being review by the District/LAN
  - Roof consultant continues with their roof assessment district-wide

#### Construction

- E.F. Green Junior School
  - Grade beams at building pads are underway
  - Hanging steel joists and decking installation progresses
  - Installing new domestic water service along Wallisville Road's right-of-way
- **Education Service Center Phase 1** 
  - Temporary Certificate of Occupancy has been issued, excluding the Fitness Center and Wellness Center
  - Fitness Center and Wellness Center will be completed by the end of October
  - C&I Department and Special Education Department have occupied the building
- Sterling High School MEP Package #1
  - Project has moved into phase 2 work that will continue through December 2020
  - Roof replacement continues at the main building
- Lee High School Auditorium Renovation
  - Demolition and abatement continues throughout the project
- District Wide MEP Package #2
  - Fan coil valves are currently being replaced at Harlem ES, DeZavala ES, and Highlands ES
  - Installation of metered faucets are underway at Gentry JS
- San Jacinto Elementary Replacement
  - General Contractor to mobilize and start site demolition in October
- Stuart CTHS Phase 4
  - General Contractor to mobilize and start site grading in October

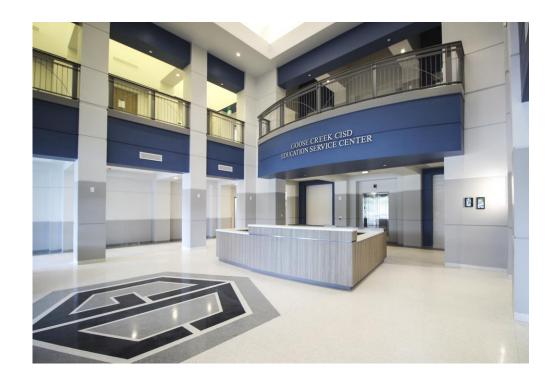
