

## **STANDARDIZED DRESS FOR PARTICIPATING CAMPUSES (GRADES PK-5)**

Ten elementary schools - Ashbel Smith, Bowie, Carver, De Zavala, Harlem, Highlands, Hopper Primary, Lamar, San Jacinto, and Victoria Walker - participate in a standardized dress code. A listing of acceptable clothing for these campuses is included below. Students at these campuses are expected to comply with the standardized dress code each day they are in attendance. The campus principal may approve special dress days outside of the standardized dress code.

### **Pants (Including Shorts / Skirts / Dresses/Jumpers / Skorts)**

Approved colors and styles include:

- Blue Denim
- Black Denim
- Navy
- Khaki (tan)

Markings on pants may only include brand name label or brand logo not to exceed a total area of 3" X 4". No other designs, emblems, or insignias are permitted on pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers, and skorts.

Leggings, if worn, must be solid in color, must extend below the knees, and must be worn with appropriate pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers, or skorts.

As per District dress guidelines, baggy pants are not allowed.

### **Tops (Including Shirts / Blouses)**

Acceptable styles include:

- Button-front style
- Turtle neck (mock and full) style
- Polo style (pullover shirt with collar, often referred to as a golf shirt)
- Sweatshirts (pullover with banded waist)
- Pocket tee style (crew neck style shirts, not to include t-shirts designed to be worn as an undergarment)
- Sweaters (pullover and button-front)
- Spirit Shirts (as approved by campus administrator)

All acceptable tops, with the exception of spirit shirts, must be solid in color with no brand logos, imprinted decorations, insignias, or other markings.

As per District dress guidelines, for students in grades 2 through 5, all tops listed above, with the exception of sweaters and pullover sweatshirts that have a banded waist, must remain tucked in.

Tops that are not of sufficient length to be tucked in are not considered to be acceptable tops.

### **Belts**

As per District dress guidelines, belts are required on all students from grades 2-5 for pants, shorts, skirts, and jumpers with belt loops.

### **Leg / Foot Attire (Socks / Tights)**

Socks must be matching and solid in color.

Footed tights may be worn under approved pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers. Footed tights must be solid in color.

**Winter Attire (Coats / Jackets / Sweaters / Sweatshirts)**

Winter attire (outer garments worn to protect against cold weather) must be full button-front style or full zippered-front style. Winter attire must remain unbuttoned and/or unzipped when allowed to be worn inside the building. The campus administrator will determine the appropriateness of wearing winter attire inside the building.

Plaid shirts and flannel jackets are not permitted as winter attire.

Sweaters and sweatshirts, when worn, must follow guidelines listed above under Tops.

Coats, jackets, sweaters, and/or sweatshirts that have an attached hood are allowed but the hood may not be worn inside the building at any time.
