## Goose Creek CISD Dedicates IMPACT Early College High School

IMPACT Early College High School opened its doors to students August 24, the first day of school this year, and the school was officially dedicated to the community November 10. Built at 1415 Market Street on the site of the old Goose Creek CISD Administration Building, the campus allows easy access to Lee College and the classes and other resources the college offers. IMPACT began in 2009 with 100 freshman students, chosen from the five junior schools when they were eighth graders, and each year approximately 100 new freshmen are accepted.

The first group of 89 graduates, many of whom had already received associate degrees from Lee College, walked across the stage to receive their high school diplomas in June 2014. This past June, 74 students graduated from IMPACT. The students who did not also earn associate degrees accumulated college hours, and many completed their degrees in the summer.

Paige Soape, president of Christian Student Union, gave the invocation, and Adamia Coverson and Steve Torres led the pledges. The national anthem was performed by the Singing Spartans. Randal O'Brien, Goose Creek CISD superintendent, welcomed everyone and recognized special quests. Jenice Coffey, president of the Goose Creek CISD Board of Trustees and Dr. Dennis Brown, president of Lee College, praised the program and the partnership between Goose Creek CISD and Lee College.

Siavash Zamirpour, Student Council President, described the opportunities that IMPACT had given him
