

District updates flyer policy

To give students more access to community activities, Goose Creek CISD has updated its flyer distribution policy.

The change allows non-profit groups such as Little League, City of Baytown, YMCA or Boy and Girl Scouts to distribute flyers directly to students to take home. Previously, groups could disseminate 25 flyers to be posted on school campuses and on the district's Web site. All flyers will still be posted on the District website.

"The impetus for change is to give our student population greater access to community events. Concern was expressed for those students and families that could not access the Internet at home," said Director of Student Services Dr. Patricia Bing.

To distribute a flyer, organizations must have an up-to-date 501-C3, and submit a copy of the flyer and a Request for Flyer Distribution Approval form to the office of Student Services for approval. Along with these changes, flyers will now be distributed weekly at campuses on Tuesdays.
