## ExxonMobil donates \$26,800 to Goose Creek CISD

ExxonMobil Chemical Plant Manager Joe Blommaert presented Goose Creek CISD Superintendent Dr. Toby York with a \$26,800 check from the ExxonMobil Foundation on Oct. 28.

That generous donation comes on the heels of two other donations of \$12,000 and \$38,000 from the oil giant.

The latest donation in support of math initiatives was made at Travis Elementary School, one of the company's partner schools in the district.

The money will be used in two areas: in support of a new signature Math Program for Goose Creek CISD students entitled MATHCOUNTS and to upgrade technology for math instruction across the district.

MATHCOUNTS is a program that inspires excellence, confidence and curiosity in junior school students through fun and challenging math programs. With the leadership of the National Society of Professional Engineers at the local and state levels, MATHCOUNTS provides students with the foundation for success in science, technology, considering and methodology. technology, engineering and mathematics careers.

Further, the ExxonMobil donation will enable the district to fund salaries for MATHCOUNTS coaches at all five junior schools, materials, training, and transportation

ExxonMobil Baytown will also supply volunteers to work with the students in an afterschool setting and host events at our site.

"I knew I wanted a career in math when I was a young student," said Joe Blommaert, ExxonMobil Chemical Plant Manager. "I hope the new math programs funded by this grant inspire Baytown students to also follow a career in math.

Blommaert transferred to Baytown in October. He was born in the Netherlands and has 21 years of service with ExxonMobil holding assignments in the Netherlands, Belgium, and the United States.

"Through this generous gift, teachers will be able to present innovative, technologybased instruction, and students will be able to participate in math lessons involving interactive technology," said Jacqueline Shuman, Goose Creek CISD Coordinator of Mathematics.

"Goose Creek is extremely pleased to be partners with ExxonMobil," said Goose Creek Superintendent Dr. Toby York. "The donation in support of math initiatives is a wonderful addition this year.
