547 students compete in junior school UIL meet

Five hundred forty seven students competed in 16 events in Goose Creek's annual junior school UIL Academic meet held May 22-23 at Gentry Junior School. Sixth, seventh and eighth grade students from every junior school campus competed with each campus represented among the winning teams or individual events.

Individual medals were awarded in prose reading, impromptu, poetry reading, number sense, general math, calculator skills, dictionary skills, listening skills, social studies, science, spelling, writing, music memory, art memory and maps, graphs and charts. Team medals were awarded for group improv. Schools also received first place trophies for overall points in each event. First through third place trophies were awarded to Gentry, Cedar Bayou and Horace Mann for having the highest cumulative points scored by students in all events.

The district wide competition was hosted by Gentry Junior School assisted by individual campus coordinators and event coaches as well as volunteer monitors, judges and graders. Winning students and teams were personally congratulated at the awards ceremony by Suzanne Heinrich, Executive Director of Secondary Education.
