Three Goose Creek elementary schools get new principals

Goose Creek CISD has named two new principals for the 2009-2010 school year, and one current principal will be transferring to another

Kevin Foxworth, former assistant principal of Sterling High School, was named the principal of Highlands Junior School in replacement of Steve Herring, who recently retired.
