The event is open to all students, parents and community members in the district and will provide information about the educational requirements for jobs in the area.

Members of various Career and Technical Education student organizations, college and career readiness counselors, and CTE teachers will be available to provide information. CTE specialists will discuss the new College and Career Academies at the high schools.

The information at Career Night may be especially helpful to 8th grade students, who will design new graduation plans in accordance with House Bill 5 requirements.

Last year, more than 200 students, some of whom were not yet in high school, attended with their parents to learn about careers.
