Tactical Test Taking/PSAT/SAT Strategies

This course is beneficial for all students who have just completed the fifth grade. It is especially helpful for those who will be eligible to participate in the Duke Talent Search during the fall of their seventh grade year.

The purpose...

The purpose of the summer course is (1) increase scholarship opportunities; (2) increase the number of colleges or universities a student can apply to and reasonably expect to be admitted; and (3) provide a solid foundation for taking any standardized test (especially the PSAT/SAT in the future).

This course, Tactical Test Taking/PSAT/SAT Strategies, is divided into the following three parts: Test Taking Skills, Verbal Skills, and Math Skills.

The course uses a "building block" approach which requires a student to change how he/she thinks as well as how he/she responds to questions based on the question type.

All junior high school students will strengthen their opportunity for success on the PSAT/SAT by attending the three preparation courses offered in the summer by the district.

It's a fact that ...

If you don't score high enough on the SAT/ACT, you may be turned down by the college of your choice.

The PSAT, if taken in the 11th grade is used to determine the National Merit Scholarship semifinalists.

Late in the junior year is a good time to take the SAT/ACT. The SAT is given to seventh grade students to determine recognition and eligibility for the Duke Talent Search Program.
