Graduation ceremonies for Goose Creek Memorial High School, Ross S. Sterling High School, and Robert E. Lee High School will be held on June 7, 2014 at Hofheinz Pavilion on the University of Houston campus. Hofheinz Pavilion provides an indoor setting that can seat as many as 8,000 people.

Each campus will have its own graduation ceremony at a designated time on June 7, 2014. All graduating students will meet in advance on campus at a predetermined time and be transported by bus to Hofheinz Pavilion. Through a campus-based reservation system, school buses will also be available to transport parents or relatives who may need a ride to Hofheinz Pavilion.

Handicap seating in the arena is available and no stairs are involved to get to it. There are suites along the entrance floor dedicated solely for handicap people. One family member is allowed to sit with each handicap person.

Guests must exit Hofheinz Pavilion after each graduation ceremony.

Loved ones, who are unable to attend the ceremonies, will be able to watch the graduation ceremonies live via the Web. Goose Creek CISD will broadcast live the graduation ceremonies at www.gccisd.net.

The graduation ceremonies will be available for viewing on the Goose Creek CISD web site at a later date.

Graduation Information and Deadlines

In early May, graduating seniors will receive a packet of information to take home regarding graduation responsibilities, procedures, and due dates.

This packet will include:

- Letter from principal
- Student check-out information
- Graduation picture information
- Time for graduating students to arrive on campus the day of graduation
- Bus reservation system for parents and relatives in need of being transported
- Maps, directions, available parking lots, etc.

What should I expect the day of graduation?

Students

- All graduating students will be riding GCCISD buses from their home campus to Hofheinz Pavilion.
- Students must arrive on campus at a predetermined time that has been communicated by their principal.
- Students should arrive on campus appropriately dressed for the ceremony. Caps and gowns will be put on at Hofheinz Pavilion.
- Restroom facilities will be limited. Therefore, use the restroom before you board the bus.

Hofheinz Pavilion's Don'ts and Do's

Don'ts

The following items are NOT allowed in Hofheinz Pavilion:

- Air Horns
- Artificial Noise Makers
- Balloons
- Glass Vases
- Signs
- Banners
- Outside Food or Beverages, except bottled water

- Tripods are not allowed in the arena

NOTE: Please know that any wrapped gifts will be opened and checked by security personnel at the entry doors.

Family Members

- GCCISD bus transportation will be provided for family members through a campus-based reservation system.
- Additional information regarding the reservation system will be sent home in early May 2014.
- Food, drinks (other than bottled water), gifts, noise makers, banners, and posters should be left at home as they are not allowed in Hofheinz Pavilion.
- Family members may begin arriving at Hofheinz Pavilion one hour prior to the ceremony.
- Wear comfortable shoes for walking. Close parking is limited.

Do's

- Enter through the Holman Street entrance of Hofheinz Pavilion.
- Family members may begin arriving one hour before each ceremony.
- Saved seats must be released 20 minutes prior to the beginning of the ceremony.
- Bottled water is allowed.
- Cameras are allowed; however, tripods are not allowed.



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
