

REL Marine Corps Ball

The Robert E. Lee High School Marine Corps Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps (MCJROTC) celebrated the 239th birthday of the Marine Corps recently with a Marine Corps Ball. Approximately 75 people attended the Ball, held in the Commons of Lee High School.

The first part of the Ball was formal, including a traditional march on with Commanding Officer Cadet 2nd Lt. Ray Boone and the guest of honor, Renea Dillon, director of career and technical education for Goose Creek CISD; Colors and the traditional cakecutting ceremony, followed by the reading of the 13th Commandant's Birthday Message and the current Commandant's Birthday Message. The last part of the Ball included dinner and dancing.
