AVID Student Selected to Speak at Summer Institute

Laurencia Nwankwo, a Goose Creek Memorial High School senior, is one of 16 students selected from 1300 entries nationwide in the AVID Speaker Contest, an annual speech contest hosted by the National AVID Institute.

In their speeches, students share their stories about how AVID has helped them in the pursuit of their dreams of attending fourvear universities.

AVID, an acronym for Advancement Via Individual Determination, is a program founded in San Diego, California, in 1980 to address the needs of students who were underrepresented in colleges and universities across America.

The program has expanded internationally and has created hope for hundreds of thousands of students in 48 states and 16 countries who otherwise would not have developed the tools for entering the world of higher learning.

AVID's mission is to close the achievement gap by preparing all students for college readiness and success in a global society.

Nwankwo is the first AVID student in GCCISD to be awarded this honor. In addition to being one of two student keynote speakers at the first San Antonio AVID Summer Institute for Teachers and Administrators, she will be awarded a \$500 scholarship for her efforts. She is the youngest of seven siblings, and she is determined to attend a four-year university.

Her heartfelt message includes gratitude to her mother for her love and sacrifice as she has raised her daughter; sadness and grief over the fact that her father who lives thousands of miles away in Africa has been unable to be physically present for many milestones in his daughter's life; and how her involvement in the AVID program has encouraged her and helped her to become the determined, focused young woman she is today.
