## Bond update on construction

Bond projects, including construction of the three new elementary schools, continue to progress in Goose Creek CISD. A pivotal part in the construction process is that two new campuses have erected "red iron" in the past week, with the third to follow in weeks to come.

As the "red iron" extends into the sky, the buildings begin to take shape, specifically at the 7770 Eastpoint site, where developments include the architectural accents. The new Alamo campus, located at 6100 N. Main, is in approximately the same stage as the Eastpoint campus. The third campus, located at 6033 N. Hwy. 146, has underground beams and piers, with the slab in the process of being poured and "red iron" to follow at that site as well.

"The objective is for all three schools to be built simultaneously, but schedules are adjusted throughout the 10-month plan according to weather conditions and material availability," said Randal O'Brien, deputy superintendent of administrative services.

Future projects include the Transportation Center and Technology Center. Sites are currently being considered.

The Citizens Bond Advisory Committee, with Pete Alfaro as chair, has met twice with District representatives to consider various projects and make recommendations. One of the purposes of this committee is to review and endorse construction schedules and progress.
