GCCISD graduations this week

Goose Creek CISD high school seniors are ready to don caps and gowns for their big walk across the stage

On Thursday, June 7, Ross S. Sterling High School will kick off three consecutive commencements at Stallworth Stadium. Robert E. Lee High School seniors will graduate on Friday, June 8, and Goose Creek Memorial High School seniors will graduate on Saturday, June 9. All three ceremonies begin at 8 p.m.

Archer Road will be closed between the two north exits at Stallworth Stadium starting at 7 p.m. No through traffic east or west will be allowed after the section of street is closed.

This means that vehicles leaving from those two exits can only go one-way, left for the west side and right from the east side. The road closure will end after graduation.

To ensure the safety of graduates and audience members and maintain the dignity of the occasion, Goose Creek CISD has compiled a list of items that will not be permitted at Stallworth Stadium during the upcoming Lee, Sterling, and Goose Creek Memorial graduations.

Among the items that will be prohibited inside the stadium are balloons, weapons or firearms, air horns/whistles or other mechanical noisemakers, food of any kind, coolers or containers, fireworks or explosives, illegal substances, Frisbees and beach balls, laser pens, or knives of any size, including Leatherman's and multi-purpose tools.

Audience members should dress appropriately — that means no profane or sexually lewd clothing. Anyone dressed inappropriately will be denied entry into the stadium. Additional security at graduation will enforce the rules.

In case of rair

In the event of rain, the Lee High School graduation ceremony will take place in the Lee High School Auditorium.

Each graduate will be given four tickets for their family members. The school will also have the Boys Gym set up for the overflow of people that do not have tickets.

Below is a summary step by step.

- 1. Students report to Stallworth Stadium on Friday morning for practice. If it is raining we have administrators present who instruct them to go to Lee High School for practice.
- Students receive their four rainout tickets in the event that it is raining on
- Friday night.
 Students are instructed to keep a close eye on the weather during the day on
- If it rains during the day on Friday, the school is asking the students to regularly check the GCCISD website to see if the ceremony has officially been moved to the Lee High School Auditorium.

 The school will also send out an IRIS message if the ceremony is moved.
- If the ceremony is moved to Lee High School we have all graduates report to the girls gym.
- The school divide them by where they will sit and have one half report to the cafeteria while the other half stays in the girls gym.

 Students will march into the auditorium in unison and they will sit on the stage.

After the ceremony concludes the graduates pick up their diplomas in the
