

## **Credit Union partners with district** for new scoreboard at Stallworth Stadium

The scoreboard and video system at Stallworth Stadium is obsolete and no longer supported by the company for maintenance purposes.

Thus, Goose Creek CISD is replacing the existing scoreboard and video system at Stallworth Stadium with a much larger video board (22-foot by 16-foot, 9 inches) to provide larger images with much greater resolution. (The current scoreboard is 11-foot by 14foot, 8 inches.)

The school district recently approached Community Resource Credit Union to participate in the purchase of the new scoreboard and video system at 60 percent of the cost with a 10-year extension of their contract.

CRCU officials agreed to participate and donated \$166,637 toward the purchase.

"At CRCU, we strongly believe in education and are pleased to continue our Stallworth Stadium sponsorship with GCCISD," said David Frazier, Community Resource Credit Union's President and CEO. "We were excited to donate the scoreboard in 2006, and are especially thrilled to help provide a larger video board that will elevate the experience for all persons that attend an event at Stallworth Stadium.

Spectrum Scoreboards will install the new scoreboard and video system and remove the existing scoreboard for \$277,728.

The district is paying \$139,091 to provide the district's portion of the funding for the new scoreboard. This funding includes \$111,091 for the scoreboard, \$20,000 for additional foundation work, and \$8,000 to upgrade the electrical service.

"The new scoreboard and video board will enhance our facility a great deal. In addition to the increase in size and improved resolution, the new system will allow us to provide instant replay for our spectators," said Goose Creek Athletic Director Tom Ed Gooden. "We are very grateful to Community Resource Credit Union for their continued support for our district.'

The new scoreboard is expected to be in place by next school year's first home football game on Thursday, Aug. 30 — Goose Creek Memorial versus Lumberton. Lee and Sterling will continue their rivalry on the following night at Stallworth.
