

Mathletes fare well in competition: Highlands Junior team to compete at state level

The MATHCOUNTS program in Goose Creek CISD has hit a new high. "Mathlethes" spend countless hours calculating equations, learning formulas, and doing high school level mathematics to prepare. Fifty Goose Creek CISD students participated in the Second annual MATHCOUNTS District competition on Jan. 29, and 36 advanced to the Bay Area MATHCOUNTS competition.

The junior school competitions - in which students test their skills in a fast-paced "bee"-style competition - aim to spark an interest in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.

Started by the National Society of Professional Engineers and the National Council of Teacher of Mathematics, the MATHCOUNTS program is not about tedious math work and basic calculations. Instead, it celebrates the problem-solving, creative and applied side of math where equations and formulas can offer solutions for everyday life. Students compete both as individuals and as teams of four.

In each competition students compete in four rounds. In the sprint round, students have 40 minutes to solve 30 problems. The target round consists of 4 rounds in which students are challenged to solve 2 problems in 6 minutes. The team round lasts 20 minutes, and students collaboratively complete a 10question exam. Depending on their individual score, finalists can advance to the Jeopardy-like countdown/final round.

Eight schools competed in the Bay Area chapter MATHCOUNTS competition on Saturday, Feb. 26. Out of the 60 competitors, 36 were from the five Goose Creek CISD junior high schools Baytown, Cedar Bayou, Gentry, Highlands, and Horace Mann.

The Highlands Junior team, coached by Michelle Williams, placed second in the team round. They qualified to advance to the state competition in Austin on March 26. The winner circle includes: Kyrie Yong, Pooja Bhula, Chinmayee Kulkarni, and Erika Padilla. Students around the district are cheering on the advancing "mathletes" in hopes of going to MATHCOUNTS Nationals in May in Washington, D.C.

The Gentry Junior team, coached by Laura Heinrich, placed fourth. The team includes Nathan Kelly, Ayesha Patel, Cameron Jackson, and Akila Patel.

Goose Creek CISD had four students that placed in the top 25 percent of the competition: Kyrie Yong of Highlands Junior placed fifth; Pooja Bhula also from Highlands Junior placed 11th; Nathan Kelley of Gentry placed 12th; and Kayla Stears of Cedar Bayou placed 13th.

"The implementation of the District's MATHCOUNTS program has been a collaborative effort between our Superintendent Dr. Toby York, our professional and industry partners such as the Bay Area Chapter of the Texas Society of Professional Engineers, ExxonMobil, and Community Resource Credit Union, community leaders such as Spencer Carnes, Tucker Coughlin, and Connie Tilton, as well as the District's math department," said Jacqueline Shuman, Goose Creek CISD's Coordinator of Mathematics K-12.
