Sterling girls earn 4th-straight state water polo championship

Ross S. Sterling High School's girls water polo team captured the state championship title on April 16 at the TISCA state tournament at Conroe ISD's Natatorium in Conroe.

Remarkably, it is the team's fourth straight Texas Interscholastic Swimming Coaches Association (TISCA) state championship.

The Sterling girls claimed the title with a 10-4 win over Clear Lake.

"Winning for the fourth year in a row is something that doesn't happen very often. I have been fortunate to have been a part of this as a player (Clear Lake HS 1994-1998) and as a coach here at Sterling. The feeling is indescribable; I am just so proud of the girls, they were phenomenal," said RSS head water polo coach TJ Markiewicz.

"They did a fantastic job all season and exceeded my expectations. It is true that hard work and determination pay off, and these girls are a testament to that. It is a pleasure to coach athletes who care so deeply about their sport and would give anything to be able to play." The Sterling girls finished the season with a record of 29-4.

Sterling's Madison Pepper was named TISCA Girls All State MVP. Pepper's teammates Darla Vasquez, Eunice Alaniz, and Kaci New were named to the All-State 1st Team.
