



## Stuart Career Center car show set for May 7

Goose Creek CISD's John M. Stuart Career Center will host a car show and open house on Saturday, May 7.

The school's inaugural car show will take entries in 13 categories — including Pre '50s, classic '50s and '60s, muscle cars, rat rods, low riders, trucks, under 21, an open class, imports and more — and award plaques to the winners.

Beginning at 8 a.m., visitors to the show can look at the cars entered in the show and more. There will be activities for kids, racecars on display, a DJ and music, and concessions.

It will cost \$25 to register at the show. Entries will be accepted from 8 a.m. until noon on Saturday. Judging starts at noon.

Proceeds from the show will benefit the Career Center, which helps prepare students for high tech, high wage careers in high demand fields.

Students at Stuart Career Center are offered courses in auto technology, auto body repair, computer technology, culinary arts, meat processing, robotics, ATV and marine small engine repair and carpentry construction technology, business, and landscape design.

High school career and technical education is and will continue to be a high-priority for Goose Creek. Why? Because reports show that 85 percent of jobs in Texas require a college degree post-secondary education, and many of GCCISD's Career & Technical Courses give students a head start on college through articulated college credits. but close to 100 percent require a high school diploma.

It is the mission of John M. Stuart Career Center to provide an education that allows all students the opportunity to apply academic skills in a vocational technical setting. Students from each of the district's high schools can enroll at Stuart Career Center to get a head start on training for their chosen career, explore a field of interest, and gain knowledge and skills about the work world.

CTE enrollment across the district is up — now well over 5,000 students.
