



Change in Grade Classification Standards

Beginning with the 2011-2012 school year, the freshman class of 2007-2008 was the first class of students who were required to earn 26 credits to graduate on the Recommended Graduation Plan.

Additionally, beginning with the freshman class of 2011-2012, students are required to successfully perform on 12 End of Course Exams on a cumulative basis.

Therefore, to effectively support and track students, the District has implemented this change in grade classification.

Grade Classification

- 9th Grade First Year in High School
- 10th Grade Second Year in High School
- 11th Grade Third Year in High School
- 12th Grade 19.5 Credits Earned

Grade classification standards are published in the High School Parent/Student Handbook and the High School Course Description Guide.
