Last year, more than 200 students participated and brought in 2 tons of food.

Thanks to Principal Don Beck, and Sterling's Partners in Education, San Jacinto Methodist Hospital, all participants will be served pizza, cookies and drinks. Prizes will be given to the teams who bring in the most items as well as the best-dressed team.
