College Board AP tests will be given May 3-14

Attention Goose Creek CISD high school students: College Board Advanced Placement tests will be given May 3 through May 14.

AP tests are given in specific subject areas and are used to determine if a student may gain advanced standing and/or college credit.

Why participate?

Here are three good reasons:

- More than 90 percent of four-year colleges provide credit and/or advanced placement for qualifying scores.
- By passing the AP test(s), you can stand out in the college admissions process by demonstrating your maturity and readiness for college.
- Get a head start on college-level work. See list of AP exams being offered [here](#).

How much?

Thanks to a \$30 subsidy provided by the Texas Legislature, a test rebate fee, and additional funding by Goose Creek CISD, the cost of the test has been reduced from \$86 to \$27 per exam per students paying the full amount. For students who qualify for reduced fees from the College Board, the subsidy and test rebate fee lowers the cost to \$15 per examination. OK now what? Sign up.

- Robert E. Lee High School students may reserve tests in Room 205, the social studies computer lab, on Thursday, Feb. 18, from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Ross S. Sterling High School students may reserve tests in the RSS Professional Library, on Tuesday, Feb. 16, from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Goose Creek Memorial High School students may reserve tests in the Career Center, on Wednesday, Feb. 17, from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

All students wishing to reserve AP exams will pay a non-refundable fee of \$13 cash for each exam ordered. For example, a student who is reserving three tests pays \$39. Fees paid to reserve tests will be deducted from the amount owed on the day of the exam.

This amount will be \$14 per exam for students who do not qualify for a reduced fee. The \$13 non-refundable fee for reserving each exam is based on a \$13 cost paid by the district for each test ordered but not taken.

If students cannot sign up for AP exams on the day assigned to each high school campus, sign up and payments will be taken at the Goose Creek CISD Administration Building, 4544 I-10 East, in rooms 243 and 246 through March 22.
