Survey of high school student aimed at determining the needs of their peers

In the spring of 2009, members of the Baytown Youth Advisory Commission decided to take on a project of determining the needs of their peers in Baytown. The goal in the compilation of the survey was to find the teens thoughts and opinions and to present the results to the various government and advisory boards of the city.

The overall goal was to get the dialogue started and action moving on improving the quality of life for the youth of Baytown and make this a more attractive place for the youth of Baytown to make this community a place to come back and reside as adults.

Representatives from the Baytown business community, Goose Creek CISD, City of Baytown, Communities In Schools and the Youth Advisory Commission, compiled the Through the gracious generosity and support of Goose Creek CISD, students at Robert E. Lee High School, Ross S. Sterling High School and Goose Creek Memorial High School were given class time to complete the survey.

In all, 4,854 students completed the survey that represents 83 percent of all students enrolled in the high schools of Baytown. With 75 percent of participation of enrolled students from Goose Creek Memorial, 93 percent of participation of enrolled students from Robert E. Lee, and 80 percent of participation of enrolled students from Ross S. Sterling, the survey was felt to give an accurate representation of the opinions of the students within the community.
