GCCISD to Administer TAKS Exit Level Retests July 13-16, 2010

Goose Creek CISD will administer the exit level Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) retests July 13-16, 2010.

The testing schedule is as follows:

- Tuesday, July 13, 2010:** TAKS Exit Level English Language Arts
- Wednesday, July 14, 2010:** TAKS Exit Level Math
- Thursday, July 15, 2010:** TAKS Exit Level Science
- Friday, July 16, 2010:** TAKS Exit Level Social Studies

Goose Creek CISD students who were enrolled in grades 11 and 12 in the spring of 2010 are eligible to take any section of the test for which they have not yet met the passing standard.

Goose Creek CISD students who meet the eligibility criteria are already preregistered to test.

Out-of-School and out-of-district students who have not yet met the passing standard on all sections of the test are also eligible to take any section of the test for which they have not met the passing standard.

Lee High School students will be administered the test at Lee High School and should report to the auditorium.

Sterling High School students will be administered the test at Sterling High School and should report to the auditorium.

Memorial High School students will be administered the test at Memorial High School and should report to the auditorium.

All examinees need to arrive at their testing sites by 7:30 a.m. on the day(s) of testing. Students must have a picture ID in order to test.
