AVID, "Advancement Via Individual Achievement," is an international student success initiative founded in 1980 in California by Mary Catherine Swanson.

Swanson refers to herself regularly as "just an English teacher," but her personal determination to motivate and inspire middleachieving, first generation college-capable students led to her being the first teacher in history to receive the prestigious Pioneering Achievement in Education Award, presented by the Charles A. Dana Foundation, in 1995.

The Goose Creek CISD Board of Trustees and district administrators approved the AVID program in 2003 and the district got on board with what is statistically proving to be the most successful and widespread college readiness program in

Students who are selected for the program are fortunate to have the opportunities that the district is providing.

These opportunities include learning how to be ready for college in the areas of organizational and study skills, how to fill out college applications and scholarship applications, visits to colleges, and participation in an elective class that provides the academic, emotional, and practical support they need to maintain success in higher level courses.
