Projects Review Brenda Garcia

COLLEGE AND CAREER CENTER

- Project will provide professional development space, a place for advanced college coursework/community academic research and a location for college & career districtwide activities
- The purpose of the project is to close the gap on the attainment of a college degree for GCCISD students and community
- Total Projected Budget is \$39,500,000



SPECIAL OLYMPICS FACILITY

- Project will provide a designated facility for training and hosting Special Olympics and SPED program athletic events
- The project's dual purpose and benefit will be to provide all Stuart Career Tech HS students a designated physical education facility
- Total Projected Budget is \$18,400,000



STERLING HS REPLACEMENT

- Project will replace the main building due to its aging and damaged structural foundation system and replace the Winnie Brown Gym, Natatorium, and Vocational building
- Project will leave the East Annex, Field House and the New Cafeteria in place
- Project will construct a 21st century learning high school campus
- Total Projected Budget is \$285,000,000



SAFETY AND SECURITY

- Project will upgrade main entry access, door hardware, intercom systems, add gun/vape detection systems, bullet-resistant film, and Police Department vehicles
- The purpose of this project is to enhance the safety and security
 of GCCISD to further support the growth of our District and our strategic
 plan
- Total Projected Budget is \$24,000,000



TECHNOLOGY

- Project will refresh mobile devices at elementary and junior schools
- Project will refresh network hardware at most facilities to ensure the continuous operation and communication across the District
- Total Projected Budget is \$20,000,000



TRANSPORTATION

- Project will replace buses per the district replacement cycle and obtain new equipment, specialized tooling, and replace dated technology
- Project will procure 35 new buses to replace old buses as well as increase the fleet count
- Project will outfit buses with new cameras, student tracking hardware, and shop equipment
- Total Projected Budget is \$6,200,000



ATHLETICS

- Project will address aging and outdated facilities and equipment that has exceeded it useful life
- Project will replace batting cages, resurface HS running tracks and tennis courts, renovate weightrooms, and upgrade bleachers and scoreboards
- The purpose is to provide appropriate training and competition facilities that promote maximum-performing athletes
- Total Projected Budget is \$5,400,000



OLD SAN JACINTO ES DEMOLITION

- Project will demolish the old San Jacinto Elementary campus
- The campus is outdated and does not meet the District's educational standards
- Total Projected Budget is \$510,000



FACILITIES CONDITION ASSESSMENT

- Project will upgrade mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and building systems that are at the end of their life cycle
- Project scope will include roofing, building envelopes, foundations, site improvements, and painting to correct deficiencies and extend lifespans
- Project will address the highest priority deficiencies, maximize operational use of each facility, and minimize emergency expenditures
- Total Projected Budget is \$15,000,000



LEE H.S. SITE RENOVATION

- Project will address various site improvements, including modification of pedestrian and vehicular circulation, increase green space, and relocation of athletic courts
- Project will promote a safer pedestrian and vehicular experience for students and staff
- The District has received written confirmation from the City of Baytown regarding their intent to transfer ownership of Carnegie St.
- Total Projected Budget is \$6,200,000



STALLWORTH STADIUM RENOVATION

- Project will address grandstand ramps, code updates, structural repairs, replacement of systems and facilities with moisture intrusion issues, press box replacement, mechanical systems upgrades, and ADA compliance
- The purpose of the project is to benefit students involved in athletics, fine arts, career and technical education programs, and upgrade the stadium's functional use
- Total Projected Budget is \$24,000,000



NEW STADIUM

- Project will construct a new 9,000 seat stadium to include a press box, locker rooms, officials' locker rooms, concessions, audio-visual support space, band staging areas, and associated support spaces
- New stadium will provide modern facilities to support athletics, fine arts,
 CTE programs, and District-wide events
- Project budget includes funding for the acquisition of land
- Total Projected Budget is \$105,000,000





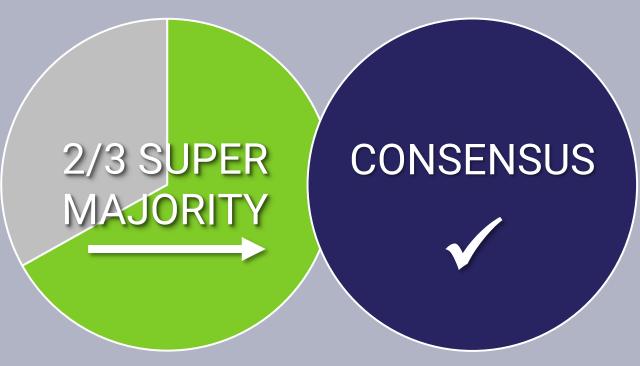

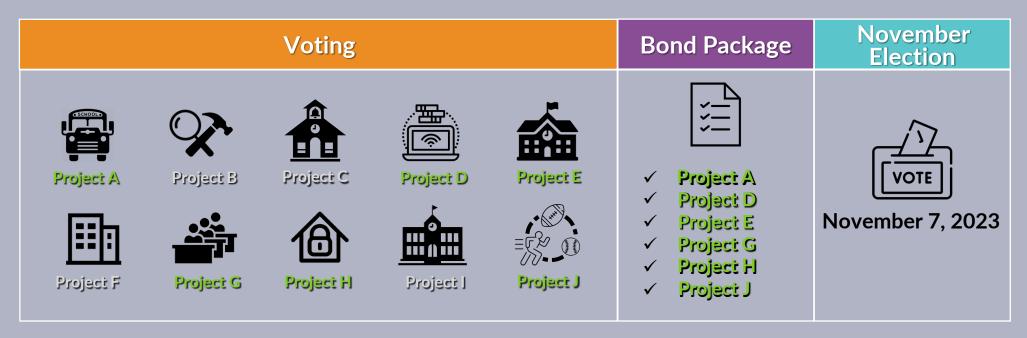
