

- Project will replace the main building due to its aging and damaged structural foundation system and replace the Winnie Brown Gym, natatorium, and vocational building.
- Project will leave the East Annex, field house, new cafeteria, and athletics fields in place.
- Project will be constructed in several phases spanning over mutiple years.
- The district plans for students and staff to remain in the main building until the

- completion of the first academic building.
- Once the new academic building is complete, the construction of new fine arts and athletics facilities will begin. Upon the completion of the new buildings, the main building will be demolished.
- The Sterling site is approximately 68 acres, which is adequate space for the replacement. The existing site allows space for new facilities to be constructed with minimal impact to the existing campus.
