DATA TALK/ASSESSMENT SHUTDOWNS

James Husband received feedback regarding the amounts of testing shutdowns and how it impacts instructional times. Committees and plans were developed and shared with ILC.

GC2035 UPDATE

Kendall David shared a presentation regarding district rezoning for 2025-26. Beginning in May there was a demographic study. Many individuals reviewed facilities and evaluated a rezoning plan. Rezoning plan is to

balance enrollment, make efficient resource use and to promote equity.
This was a very comprehensive study.

GC2035 is recommending a 10-yr long range facility plan to our Board.

The plan refers to a need to create efficiency at all campuses.

We will provide rezoning recommendations to the board February 3, 2025.

December 16th Board meeting is called to specifically look at repurposing campuses.

SCIENCE/MATH ACCELERATION

Kevin Wroblewski, Associate Director for Science and HS Health shared a power point presentation.

Honors Accelerated 6th & 7th Gr Science & Honors IPC which means the TEKS will be taught in 5th & 7th and will take the “Middle School Science STAAR” at the end of 7th gr.

This will increase the rigor and will receive a HS Science credit.

May 2025 – training for staff that will teach the course.

Dr. Shannon Ramirez shared how students qualify. (5th gr 2024-25)

Middle school students in IPC will take a final exam at the end of each semester. Grades for IPC will appear on the student’s HS transcript.

Angela Cornelius, Associate Director for Math spoke about the SB 2124 Honors 6th Mathematics Auto Enroll. The New Advanced Math Pathways Report in TPRS was shared along with the new TEKS review schedule.

There is a proposal for Accelerated 5th Gr Math which will allow 8th graders to take Geometry: 5th Grd - 5th & 6th TEKS/6th STAAR; 6th Grd – 7th & 8th TEKS/ 7th STAAR; 7th Grd – Alg 1 TEKS/Alg 1 EOC; 8th Grd – Geo TEKS/8th STAAR Summer 2025 – Geometry for initial credit offering; opportunity to accelerate HS Math.
