Dear Parent,

The 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 School Report Cards (SRC) for the district and the district's campuses are now available on the district's website (www.gccisd.net) under accountability and online at the [TEA School Report Card](#).

This report is required by the Texas Legislature and prepared by the Texas Education Agency. It is to be available to the parent or guardian of every child enrolled in a Texas public school. The report provides information concerning student performance on the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR®), College, Career, and Military Readiness, as well as information on student enrollment, class size averages, and financial expenditures.

Due to judicial proceedings, the release of the 2024 School Report Card was significantly delayed.

The information contained in the School Report Card is required by state law and much of the technical language used is defined and described in the available 2024 School Report Card Definitions and the 2025 School Report Card Definitions. The report may or may not have all the information described because the information presented depends on whether the school is an elementary, middle, or high school.

State law requires that the School Report Card display information about the state, the district, and the school. Where possible, the information must be reported by race/ethnicity and socioeconomic status of the students and must include at least two years of results. The Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR) is available at [Texas Academic Report Cards](#) for a comprehensive report for each campus.

If you have difficulty accessing the information from the website, hard copies of the reports are available at the district or campus office. If you have questions about the information, please contact your child's campus principal.
