Projects' Status

Projects Under Construction

- Emergency Lighting Verification by Maintenance reveals more problems with code violations. Sylvania working issues. Engineer to follow up with contractor as work stalls at SFA, Crockett and Buildings. A. Smith and FMC to be reviewed and punchlist to be established.
- **MEP 4** Baytown Electric installing additional light at ROTC/Lee HS. Comex contracted to install automatic transfer switch enclosure. A/C unit in Police Department offices repaired. Parking lot lighting at the POINT Alternative School is being reprogrammed.
- FCA Project Phase 3: Projects recently approved by CBAC and BOT includes HVAC replacements and exterior door hardware. Additionally various parking lot stacking lane improvements at Gentry and Hopper are under review as A/E finishes drawing packages. Product submittals for roof replacement of Service Center, SFA, Cedar Bayou, A. Smith and San Jacinto are reviewed, approved and materials shipping. HVAC replacement chiller for BJS ordered, delivery date late July. Sterling Natatorium iwork ncludes re-plastering of the pool and deck. Lee HS Auditorium ceiling demolition to be priced shortly. Phase 4: FCA projects includes Green Center renovations. CBAC wants all funding including bond and supplemental funds be in place prior to their endorsement of renovations.
- Fencing Work continues at HJS and the POINT.
- YMCA Demolition Contract sent to low proposer for their signature.

Projects In Planning/Development

- **Green Center-** A/E preparing plans for renovation of building following flooding. This is planned to accommodate Truancy, Tax Office and Police/Security Offices. Occupants now being revisited to focus on Special Education Staff.
- Special Education Offices Relocation- Potential locations under Investigation.
- John M. Stuart Career Technology High School Phase 2 Design: Pfluger Architects schedules 75% construction documents review meeting for 6/6/18. Projected bid date now becomes contract drawing completion date due to lack of bond funding. Completed bid documents due 7/10/18.
