PURPOSE

Innovative Teaching Grants are designed to encourage, facilitate, recognize and reward innovative and creative instructional approaches and best practices in accomplishing program objectives. The Goose Creek CISD Educational Foundation (GCEF) offers teachers and other staff the opportunity to apply for grants to support innovative programs or projects that promote higher levels of student learning. The grants must enhance student academic performance and support the stated objectives, goals, and initiatives of the District/Campus Improvement Plan.





- Indicate how you will know whether the project was successful.
- Outcome should be **measurable** (i.e., increase in test scores, higher attendance, increase in students participating in programs, etc.)





Is this project sustainable or will it require <u>additional funding</u> each year?

SUSTAINABILITY

Can this project be <u>shared with</u> other teachers in your school or across the district?



BUDGETS

Prior to grant request...

- ❖ Technology (including software subscriptions) MUST be <u>pre-approved</u> by GCCISD Technology Department. Most technology will only be considered for grant funding if it is used in conjunction with an innovative program/project.
- ❖ Curriculum purchases MUST be <u>pre-approved</u> by GCCISD Curriculum Department.
- ❖ Furniture/Room Enhancements MUST be preapproved by district.







Make sure that your project is realistic and doable.



Ensure that the work you describe can be completed within the timeframe of the grant (usually one year).





Propose work that is relevant to your students' grade and abilities.



Make sure that your goals are <u>clear, achievable, and measurable.</u>
Give careful thought to <u>sustainability</u> issues and address the <u>impact</u> your project will have beyond the life of the grant.



As with any written task, you should write <u>clearly</u> and <u>concisely</u> in your own voice. Use language that educators not necessarily familiar with your subject, grade, or geographic area can understand.



Avoid using field- and geography-specific jargon and acronyms, since these may be lost on members of the review panel.


