

Impact Early College High School at Lee College Application GCCISD

Below is the application to the Impact Early College High School at Lee College. The deadline to return the application is **Tuesday, April 10th, 2012 to your 8th grade counselor.**

Early College High School will award priority points to applicants who are:

1. First generation college student,
 2. Students who come from groups that historically have lower than average high school completion, college attendance, and graduation rates,
 3. Students who qualify for free or reduced lunch based on family income,
 4. Classified At Risk based on the state definition for students at risk of not graduating,
 5. English language learners.
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To apply, you must:

- a. **Completely** fill out the application form and return it on time to your counselor.
 - b. **Be a resident of Goose Creek Consolidated Independent School District**
 - c. Provide proof of residency (a copy of entire current utility bill, gas, electric or a lease agreement with the student listed as a resident)
 - d. Have a good attendance and behavior record
 - e. Have a strong work ethic*
 - f. Go through the interview process
- * Two recommendations will be required from your current campus. One of the two recommendations must come from an 8th grade math, science, social studies, or English teacher.**
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The general eligibility to be considered for admission into the Impact Early College High School located at Lee College are as follows:

- **The student must be a resident of Goose Creek Consolidated Independent School District**
 - The student must meet the requirements for promotion from 8th to 9th grade including 90% attendance, 70% overall GPA in core subjects, and mastery of the first administration of the spring 2010 TAKS Math and Reading tests.
 - The application must be completed.
 - The applicant must attend four days of orientation training in June of 2012.
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Impact Early College High School located at Lee College is a high school campus that students elect to attend. If the student experiences issues with attendance, tardies, behavior, low grades due to lack of effort, or an inability to pass college entrance exams, the administration at Impact reserves the right to recommend the student be removed from the Early College High School and enrolled at his/her home zoned high school campus.
