The number of students in eStar and TEAMS need to align. If there are more students in eStar than in TEAMS, then that is a discrepancy. Similarly, if there are less students in eStar than in TEAMS, then that is also a discrepancy.

Step Four: The number of students in the bilingual program, ESL, DNQ, parent denial at each grade level needs to align between eSTar and TEAMS. Select the "EL Status" field and select the desired language program. In the example, the elementary school campus has 13 students in the Bilingual program at the 5th grade level. On the TEAMS report, there also needs to be 13 students coded bilingual at the 5th grade level.
