GCCISD GIFTED/TALENTED IDENTIFICATION 1st-11th Grade Students

How do I refer my student for the GT Program in GCCISD?

- Parents/Guardians, GCCISD staff, and others may refer a 1st-11th grade student for the GT identification process by completing **an online referral during the fall semester beginning in October.** The GT referral link will be posted on the GCCISD website and the campus website. For more information, contact the campus GT Contact.
- All students who are referred for GT must have a teacher and a parent referral submitted. Parents must give permission for a student to participate in the GT identification process using the online referral. Parent permission is granted by completing and submitting the online referral.
- Students with a completed referral will participate in the GT assessment process during the spring semester.
- Any student who enrolls in GCCISD after the fall deadline can contact the Department of Advanced Academics for a GT referral.
- The GCCISD GT Identification Committee will review all assessment data to determine which students meet criteria for the GT Program. GT students are taught by a teacher who has completed 30 hours of GT training.
- GT assessment results will be mailed to parents once testing is complete. Students identified for the GCCISD GT Program will begin GT Services the following semester, pending parent permission.
- Parents/Guardians may appeal the decision of the GT Identification Committee by contacting the Department of Advanced Academics within 10 working days of the date on the notification letter.
