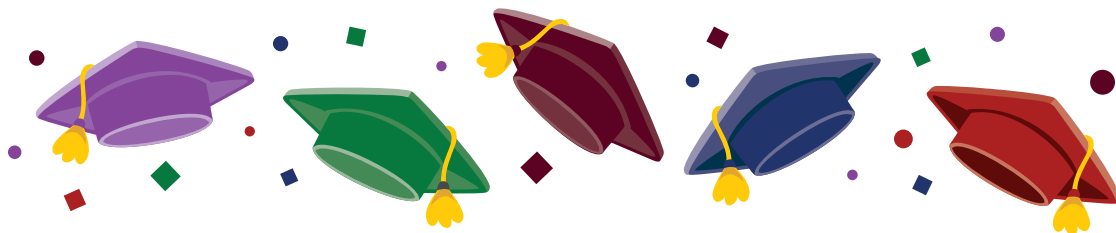

Campuses will have specific information and guidelines to which all students must adhere in order to walk at graduation.

GRADUATE GUIDELINES

- Gowns should be wrinkle-free for the ceremony.
- Caps and gowns should be worn, fully zipped to walk in the graduation ceremony.
- Caps must be worn flat, parallel to the floor. No decorations on caps.
- Tassel is worn on the right side.
- Wear comfortable clothing; it will be hot outside.
- Pants, dresses and skirts are acceptable. Ties are optional.
- Wedge heeled shoes and flats are acceptable. **NO heels, Crocs or flip flops.**
- Exemplary achievement medals, cords and pins may be worn based on district pre-approved list.
- Diplomas for RSS, REL and GCM will be passed out at the end of the ceremony. Diplomas for Stuart Career Tech and IMPACT will be distributed at the campus.
- Students from RSS, REL, and GCM who cannot be dropped off at Gentry Junior School will be shuttled from their campus starting at 5:00 PM.

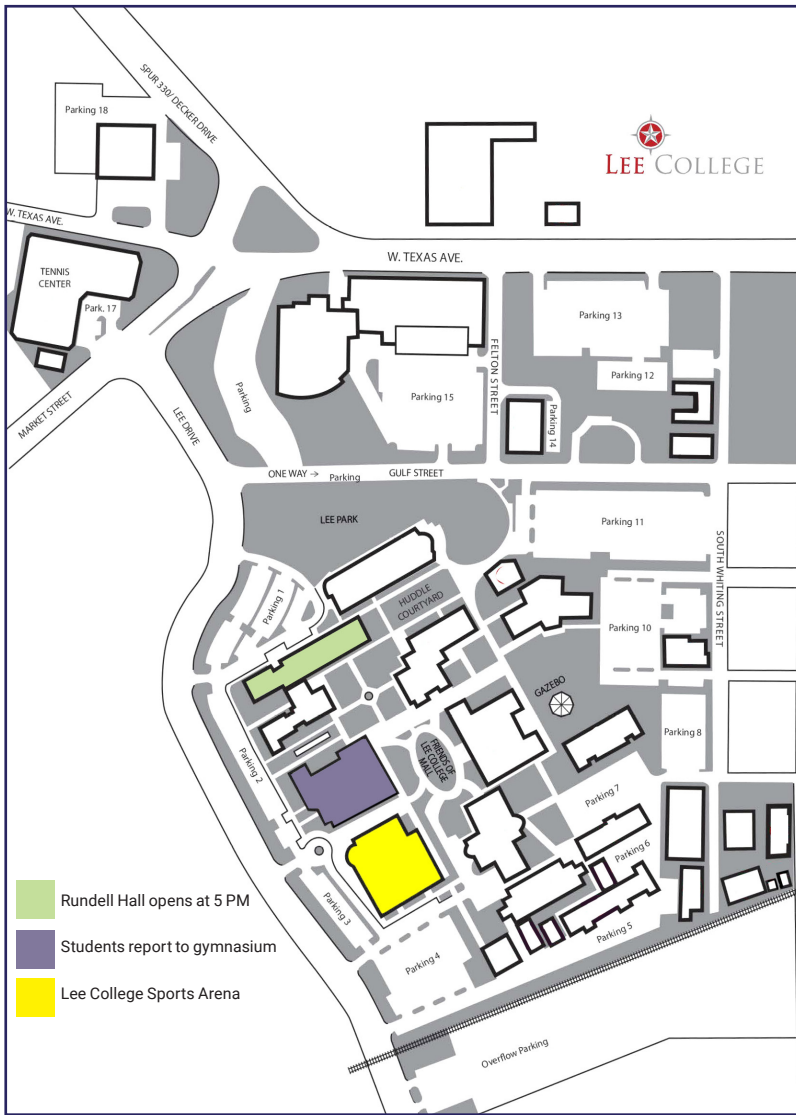

Graduation for Stuart Career Tech HS will begin at 5:00 PM. To accommodate traffic, family members are welcome to arrive starting from 4:00 PM onward. Students will ride back to Stuart Career Tech HS from Lee College.



IMPACT Early College HS graduation will begin at 7:30 PM. Family members may start arriving at 6:30 PM.

The GCCISD graduation ceremony for IMPACT Early College High School and Stuart Career Tech High School will be held on Tuesday, May 19, 2026 in the Lee College Sports Arena located at 200 Lee Drive, Baytown, Texas.

- Parking is first come, first served and is available in any permitted Lee College parking lot.
- Saving seats is not allowed.
- Please do not skip seats. Guests must move all the way down their row to ensure seats are fully utilized.
- Bottled water is allowed.
- Cameras are permitted.
- Only handheld fans are permitted.
- **Clear bag policy will be enforced.** (See page 4 for details.)
- The following items are not allowed at the ceremony: air horns, artificial noise makers, balloons, glass vases, signs, banners, tripods, and wrapped gifts.
- Rundell Hall will be open prior to the ceremony.

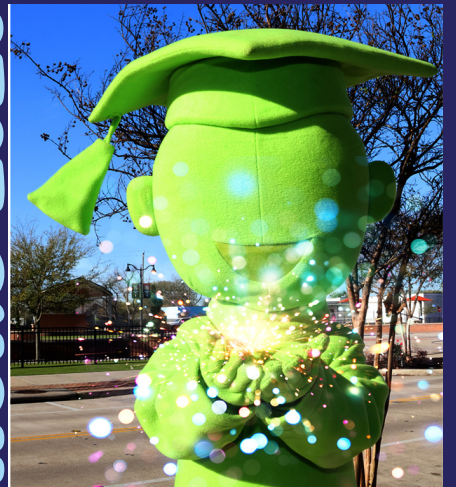

GCM, RSS AND REL AT STALLWORTH STADIUM

STALLWORTH STADIUM GUEST GUIDELINES

- Tickets and parking passes are NOT required to attend the GCCISD graduation ceremonies at Stallworth Stadium.
- **Plan ahead. Expect heavy levels of traffic.**
- Stallworth Stadium will open the home and visitor gates at 6 PM.
- The graduation ceremonies will begin promptly at 7:30 PM.
- Only handheld fans are permitted.
- **Clear bag policy will be enforced.** (See page 4 for details.)
- Do not block or stand in the aisles or on ramps to take pictures.
- Only Goose Creek CISD approved photographers are permitted on the field.
- No signs larger than a poster board are allowed.
- No signs of any kind can be attached to the railings or bleachers.
- Please use Side A or Side B for entry.
- Families are kindly asked to refrain from being on the field before, during, or after the ceremony.
- No helium balloons, air horns, bullhorns, umbrellas or laser pointers permitted.
- No drones.
- No glass containers of any kind (including vases).
- No outside food will be permitted. Sealed bottled water, soda or juice is permitted. Concession stands will be open.
- Handicapped seating will be available for the handicapped individual and **one** family member **only**.
- No pets allowed. Service animals trained to assist individuals with disabilities are welcome.

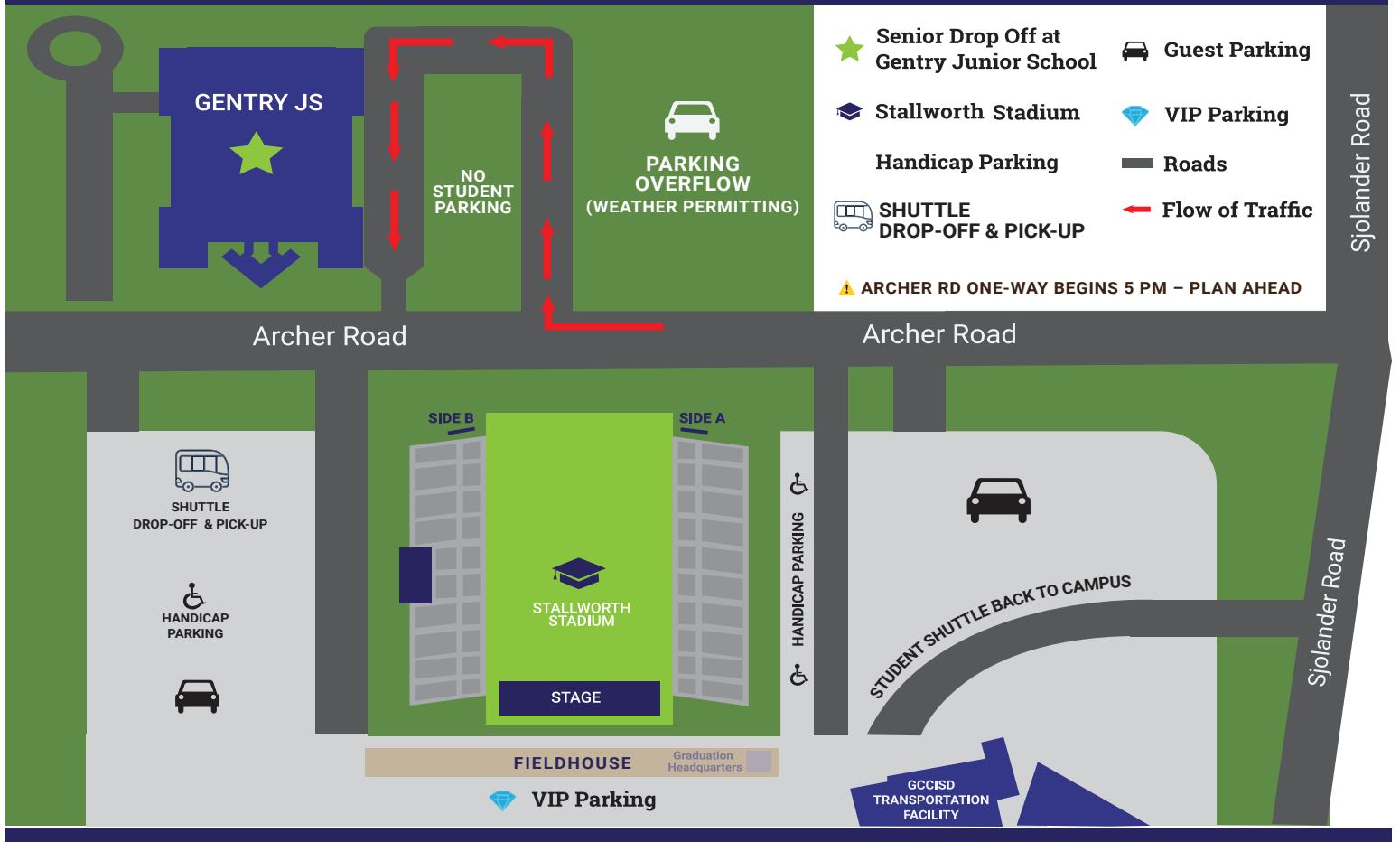

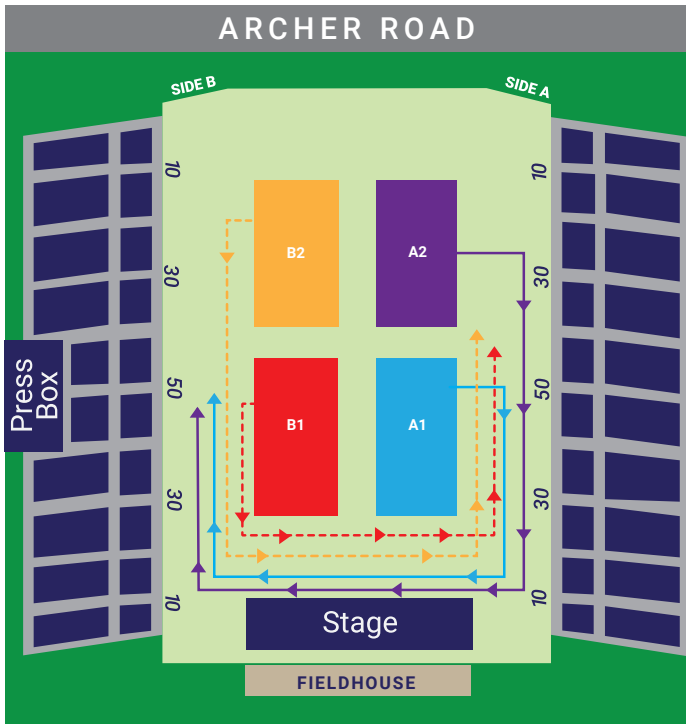
TRADITIONAL HS SENIOR DROP OFF TRAFFIC FLOW

Arrows indicate the direction graduates will face while walking and receiving their diplomas.


RAINOUT PLAN AT LEE COLLEGE

- In case of rainout, Goose Creek Memorial HS, Ross S. Sterling HS and Robert E. Lee HS graduations will be held at the Lee College Sports Arena. Students will still be dropped off at Gentry.
- Rainout communication will be sent no later than 5 PM on the day of ceremony.
- Students will receive two (2) digital tickets for rainouts, which can only be used once.
- Students will receive a QR code during graduation practice to access their rainout tickets.
- Students are responsible for distributing rain out tickets.
- Attendees can print or scan the ticket directly from their email.
- Children under the age of one (1) do not need a ticket but must be seated on a lap.
- The ceremony will be streamed on the district's website.
- No strollers or carriers will be allowed.
- No outside food or drink will be allowed other than bottled water.



Bag Policy

To ensure the safety and efficiency of entry for all attendees, the following bag policy will be enforced at all events:

Approved Bags

The following types of bags are permitted:

- Transparent Bags (no size limitations):**
 - Clear tote bags
 - Clear backpacks
 - Clear storage bags
- Non-Transparent Bags:**
 - Small purses or clutches only
 - Must not exceed 6 in (height) x 9 in (length) x 5 in (depth)

Prohibited Bags

- Any non-transparent bag exceeding the size of a small clutch (larger than 6" x 9" x 5")
- Backpacks, totes, or large purses that are not clear

Additional Guidelines

- All bags are subject to inspection upon entry
- Diaper bags and medically necessary bags may be permitted but are subject to screening
- Event staff reserve the right to deny entry for any bag that does not comply with this policy

Purpose

This policy is in place to enhance safety, reduce entry wait times, and provide a secure environment for all attendees.
