
V. BUSINESS FROM PREVIOUS YEAR

O cohort presented at campus, district and the <u>state level</u> to build comprehensive school physical activity efforts

68% of eligible K-5 classroom teachers reported teaching 1 or more CATCH Nutrition lessons each grading period to an estimated 10, 064 students

90% of 6-8 PE teachers reported teaching 1 or more CATCH Nutrition lessons each grading period to an average of 2,305 students

GCCISD completed evaluation of CATCH using Champion (2-point surveys); SPAN surveys; SOFIT; & Fitnessgram data

- 2023 S-PAPA data: 80% of all elementary schools reported they are providing
 15-20 min of daily recess (up 24% from 2022)

- An announcement was made to honor Alamo Elementary, Harlem Elementary, and IMPACT Early College schools who earned recognition and were added to the list of 2023 America's Healthiest Schools sponsored by Alliance for Healthier Generation!

VI. NEW BUSINESS

New 2023-2024 SHAC Officers were seated as a result of the vote approved at the April 18, 2023 General SHAC meeting so that the process of a timely flow of information and business could be taken in the transition to the new school year. David Reed will serve a second term as the SHAC Parent Co-Chair and Ashley Cox will serve as SHAC Secretary for 2023-2024. The 2022-2023 SHAC Membership approved the meeting minutes from the April 18, 2023 meeting minutes via virtual vote therefore there were no action items to be addressed.

Next, Mrs. Kennington shared that the Standing Subcommittees serve as the SHAC's decision-making process. They are the focal point for SHAC activity. They gather information, analyze available data, make recommendations to the full SHAC and may develop these information items into action items. District Executive Leaders shared information about some of the recommendation areas and activities from their component area and SHAC members took some time to structure and schedule subcommittees and worked briefly to identify areas for action.

Subcommittees discussed celebrations, concerns, considerations, and curiosities regarding areas to be addressed based on community member shared thoughts.

- Areas members feel should be celebrations are: annual training from BACODA and access to Narcan; Start with Hello;getting resources to parents and at a time that fits their needs; the cafeteria menu is more diverse; It's Time Texas Community Challenge participation increased
- Concerns members shared that they would like addressed this year are: communication and
 participation from caregivers and schools ensuring all staff are aware ant act when they see
 students needing guidance; learn more features of It's Time Texas Community app; more
 exercise, more PE time, good habits; lunch times too short
- Items to be considered down the road are: more trainings; use Parent Square to promote It's Time Texas Community Challenge; change discipline in cafeteria; health education, vaping
- Members shared that they would like to learn more about: collaborate with City of Baytown to promote It's Time Texas Community Challenge and improve community involvement for It's Time Texas Community Challenge; rewards for healthy eating; rewards for healthy eating
