But thanks to the Foundation, the district is provided additional resources to enrich teaching, inspire learning and provide opportunities for excellence in education for all students.

Since its inception in 2009, the Foundation has awarded 781 innovative teaching grants to more than 1,200 teachers to enhance the curriculum for their students.

The impact of these grants is more than just a monetary contribution to a classroom; these grants inspire children to the world of learning in new ways. Not every child learns the same so the educators use these funds to find creative ways to truly reach every single student in a way that will help them find success.

Every penny in the classroom goes a long way to building a new future for these children.

The Foundation is also integral to highlighting the impact teachers make on the lives of their students through the Students Choice Awards, where teachers are nominated by high school graduating seniors as they describe how many of them changed the trajectory of their lives.

Nearly 210 teachers received this honor by the Foundation.

The contributions to the Foundation also come from educators themselves through an annual "Get On the Bus" campaign. It goes to show that everyone involved is committed to enriching the hearts and minds of our children.

Together, we will build stronger classrooms and a brighter future for Baytown and beyond.


