



BOND ISSUE 2013

Goose Creek CISD voters will consider a \$267.54 million bond proposal, consisting of two propositions for school district improvements, in a May 11 bond election.

Proposition One includes projects that address district growth as projected by a demographic study by Dr. Pat Guseman of Population and Survey Analysts, Inc.

Proposition Two includes projects identified during the recent facility condition assessment by Jacobs and VLK Architects, along with site improvements identified by campus principals and proposed by the Facilities Planning Committee. Also included are safety and security improvements for each campus.

Highlights of the plan include:

- Construction of three elementary schools
- Career and Technical Education improvements
- Repurpose of Alamo Elementary to expand John M. Stuart Career Center
- Expansion of Agriculture Science facilities
- Technology improvements at all campuses
- Construction of a Data Technology and Emergency Operations Center

The bond proposal is the result of many months of work by the Facilities Planning Committee, consisting of area residents,

business and industry representatives, community leaders and District personnel.

Before presenting the proposal to the Board of Trustees, the committee considered the results of the demographic study, projecting growth of nearly 4,500 students in GCCISD over the next decade, and the facility condition assessment.

Homeowners who are over 65 years of age or disabled will experience no tax increase as a result of the bond program. The maximum estimated tax impact on other GCCISD residents would be approximately \$8.15 per month on a \$100,000 home.

Early voting will be held from April 29 through May 7 at the GCCISD Administration Building, 4544 Interstate 10 East, the Lee College District Administration Building, 909 Decker Drive, or at a number of school sites. Election Day voting will be May 11 at your regular precinct voting location.
