

NOTICE OF BOND ELECTION

TO THE RESIDENT, QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE GOOSE CREEK CONSOLIDATED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election will be held in the GOOSE CREEK CONSOLIDATED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, on the 11th day of May, 2013, in accordance with the following order:

ORDER CALLING SCHOOL BUILDING BOND ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the “Board”) of the Goose Creek Consolidated Independent School District (the “District”) finds and determines that it is necessary and advisable to call and hold an election for and within the District on the propositions hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that said election shall be held on a uniform election date established by Section 41.001(a), Texas Election Code, as amended, as required by Texas law; and

WHEREAS, the Board, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code, has agreed to enter into a Joint Election Agreement with Lee College District (the “College District”) and a rental agreement with Harris County for the use of voting machines and election equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds and declares that the meeting at which this Order is considered is open to the public, and that the public notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting was given, as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF GOOSE CREEK CONSOLIDATED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

Section 1. Findings. The statements contained in the preamble of this Order are true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings of fact and as a part of the operative provisions hereof.

Section 2. Election Ordered; Date; Proposition. An election (the “Election”) shall be held for and within the District on Saturday, May 11, 2013 (“Election Day”), in accordance with the Texas Election Code (the “Code”). At the Election the following propositions (the “Propositions”) shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the District in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION NO. ONE

SHALL THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF GOOSE CREEK CONSOLIDATED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT (THE “DISTRICT”) BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE AND SELL AT ANY PRICE OR PRICES THE BONDS OF THE DISTRICT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$177,690,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, ACQUISITION AND EQUIPMENT OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING NEW ELEMENTARY CAMPUSES, DISTRICT-WIDE CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION IMPROVEMENTS, TECHNOLOGY IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT, AND THE

PURCHASE OF NECESSARY SITES FOR SCHOOL BUILDINGS, WHICH BONDS MAY BE ISSUED IN VARIOUS ISSUES OR SERIES, SHALL MATURE SERIALY OR OTHERWISE NOT MORE THAN 40 YEARS FROM THEIR DATE, AND SHALL BEAR INTEREST AT SUCH RATE OR RATES, NOT TO EXCEED THE MAXIMUM RATE NOW OR HEREAFTER AUTHORIZED BY LAW, AS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE DISTRICT WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE; AND SHALL THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES BE AUTHORIZED TO LEVY AND PLEDGE, AND CAUSE TO BE ASSESSED AND COLLECTED, ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAXES ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT SUFFICIENT, WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO RATE OR AMOUNT, TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS AND THE COSTS OF ANY CREDIT AGREEMENTS EXECUTED OR AUTHORIZED IN ANTICIPATION OF, IN RELATION TO, OR IN CONNECTION WITH SAID BONDS; SAID BONDS TO BE ISSUED AND SAID TAXES TO BE LEVIED, PLEDGED, ASSESSED, AND COLLECTED UNDER THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS INCLUDING THE TEXAS EDUCATION CODE?

PROPOSITION NO. TWO

SHALL THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF GOOSE CREEK CONSOLIDATED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT (THE "DISTRICT") BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE AND SELL AT ANY PRICE OR PRICES THE BONDS OF THE DISTRICT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$89,850,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, ACQUISITION AND EQUIPMENT OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING, MAJOR MAINTENANCE PROJECTS, DISTRICT-WIDE SECURITY UPGRADES AND TECHNOLOGY FOR SCHOOL SITES, AND THE PURCHASE OF NECESSARY SITES FOR SCHOOL BUILDINGS, WHICH BONDS MAY BE ISSUED IN VARIOUS ISSUES OR SERIES, SHALL MATURE SERIALY OR OTHERWISE NOT MORE THAN 40 YEARS FROM THEIR DATE, AND SHALL BEAR INTEREST AT SUCH RATE OR RATES, NOT TO EXCEED THE MAXIMUM RATE NOW OR HEREAFTER AUTHORIZED BY LAW, AS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE DISTRICT WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE; AND SHALL THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES BE AUTHORIZED TO LEVY AND PLEDGE, AND CAUSE TO BE ASSESSED AND COLLECTED, ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAXES ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT SUFFICIENT, WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO RATE OR AMOUNT, TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS AND THE COSTS OF ANY CREDIT AGREEMENTS EXECUTED OR AUTHORIZED IN ANTICIPATION OF, IN RELATION TO, OR IN CONNECTION WITH SAID BONDS; SAID BONDS TO BE ISSUED AND SAID TAXES TO BE LEVIED, PLEDGED, ASSESSED, AND COLLECTED UNDER THE CONSTITUTION

AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS INCLUDING THE TEXAS EDUCATION CODE?

Section 3. Official Ballot. (a) Voting at the Election, and early voting therefor, shall be by the use of the lawfully approved County voting systems and ballots.

(b) The preparation of the necessary equipment and the official ballots for the Election shall conform to the requirements of the Code so as to permit the electors to vote “FOR” or “AGAINST” the aforesaid Propositions which shall be set forth on the ballots substantially in the following form:

Section 4. Persons Qualified to Vote. All resident, qualified electors of the District shall be eligible to vote at the Election.

Section 5. Election Precincts, Voting Locations and Voting Hours on Election Day. The election precincts for the Election shall consist of the territory within the boundaries of the District situated within one or more County election precincts, which bear the precinct numbers set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein. The voting location for voting on Election Day for each election precinct shall be as set forth in Exhibit A, or at such other locations as hereafter may be designated by Noemi Garcia (the “Presiding Election Manager”) or Judi Craig (the “Assistant Election Manager”). On Election Day the polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 6. Early Voting Locations, Dates and Times. Early voting by personal appearance for all election precincts shall be held at the locations, at the times and on the days set forth in Exhibit B, or at such other locations as hereafter may be designated by the Presiding Election Manager or the Assistant Election Manager.

Applications for ballot by mail shall be sent to: Noemi Garcia, Early Voting Clerk, Goose Creek Consolidated Independent School District Administration Building, P.O. Box 30, Baytown, TX 77522 or by telephone at 281-421-3313. Noemi Garcia is hereby appointed as the Early Voting Clerk.

Section 7. Joint Election. The District has agreed to participate in a joint election with the College District, who is also holding an election on Election Day, and has entered into a rental agreement with Harris County for the use of voting machines and election equipment.

Section 8. Appointment of Election Officers. Prior to the Election Day, the election judges, alternate judges, clerks and other personnel necessary for conducting the Election will be appointed by the Presiding Election Manager or Assistant Election Manager, and the election judges and alternate judges may be changed and the polling places may be combined for some precincts, pursuant to decisions of the Presiding Election Manager or Assistant Election Manager. The Presiding Election Manager or Assistant Election Manager shall also be responsible for establishing the central counting station for the ballots cast in such election and appointing the personnel necessary for such station. The Board hereby authorizes the President of the Board of Trustees to appoint any such other officials not designated herein or appointed by the Presiding Election Manager or Assistant Election Manager as are necessary and appropriate to conduct the Election in accordance with the Code.

In the event that the Presiding Election Manager or Assistant Election Manager shall determine from time to time (a) that one or more of the polling places hereby established and designated shall become unavailable or unsuitable for such use, or it would be in the District's best interests to relocate a polling place, or (b) that a presiding judge hereby appointed or hereinafter designated shall become unqualified or unavailable, the Presiding Election Manager or Assistant Election Manager is hereby authorized to designate and appoint in writing substitute polling places or presiding judges, giving notice as is required by the Code and as deemed sufficient.

Section 9. Notice of Election. Notice of the Election shall be given by: (i) publishing a substantial copy of this Order, in both English and Spanish in Chambers County and English, Spanish, Vietnamese and Chinese in Harris County, one time not earlier than the thirtieth day nor later than the tenth day prior to the date set for the Election, in a newspaper published in the District, and (ii) by posting a copy of this Order on the bulletin board used for posting notices of Board of Trustees meetings, not later than the 21st day prior to the date set for the Election. Notice of the Election shall also be provided to the county clerk of each county in which the District is located not later than the 60th day before the Election Day.

Section 10. Conduct of Election. Said Election shall be held in accordance with the Code, except as modified by the Texas Education Code, and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, including particularly Chapter 272 of the Code pertaining to bilingual requirements.

Section 11. Necessary Actions. The President and the Secretary of the Board of Trustees and the Presiding Election Manager or Assistant Election Manager, in consultation with the District's attorney and bond counsel are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all

actions necessary to comply with the provisions of the Code and the Federal Voting Rights Act in carrying out and conducting the Election, whether or not expressly authorized herein.
